Return to Examination Preparations For IGCSE/GCSE

This procedure is to show you how the data input works on all subjects chosen for this database. It cannot be emphasised enough the about getting this procedure correct. An incorrect entry will not meet the required data entry Form, and you will have to start again. When you begin the data entry for the Mock Examination results. you will see that all the weighting calculations have been inserted into the relevant Form. If you discover any errors as to the weighting data I have provided, please notify me as soon as possible. As I said before, I am using data from the AQA website. If you are using a different source with different data, my data is incorrect. Let me know and I will make changes for you. When you entered data for Key Stage 3 weighting, I

did not know what the weighting levels would be used for each of the subjects. Mine were made up.

Thankfully the AQA website provides all the weighting levels for all its GCSE subjects, and this is the weighting data that I have used, You will discover that the weighting required all subjects has already been entered and cannot be changed. If you discover a mistake here please let me know. All you need to enter are the Grade scores.

Do not enter date into a Form unless you see the name of the subject at the top of the Form. If you accidentally insert a teacher without a named subject, this will show up as an error when you see this data on a Form. Simply return to the student's name and delete the teacher.
